

HJC Dress Code 2017-2018

From the School Act

12 A student shall conduct himself or herself so as to reasonably comply with the following code of conduct:
(d) comply with the rules of the school

- Clothing must be appropriate for learning in a **professional** setting.
 - Footwear: footwear must be worn at all times inside the building
 - Shirts: shirts must be full length and cover midriff. Not permitted: backless or strapless tops/dresses, low cut tops/dresses, sideless tops/dresses
 - Shorts and skirts: shorts and skirts must be mid-thigh or longer.
 - All clothing must conceal undergarments.
 - Clothing and accessories shall be free of any insignia that is crude, libelous, slanderous, profane, degrading and or derogatory.

Students who appear wearing clothing that does not meet the school dress code will not be allowed to attend until they make appropriate changes to their attire.
Changes could entail changing the clothing item, removal from the normal class setting, or contacting parents to return home to obtain appropriate clothing.

*All staff members are responsible for addressing inappropriate clothing choices.
