We have one of the strongest athletic programs in the Province. Our current score clock is significantly outdated and does not work anymore. Digital score clocks/LED screens are very expensive (\$70,000-\$150,000) and schools do not receive funding from Alberta Education for these types of projects. If your company or you know of a company who would consider sponsoring our school with a financial donation to work towards our school purchasing a digital scoreboard please let me know. We have set our fundraising goal at \$80,000 due to the quote we have received.

In a typical school year we have approximately 40 home volleyball and basketball games. We have three levels of advertising that would be provided to sponsors:

Bronze - \$1,500 - The company name and logo will be part of a digital advertising banner located on the bottom of the score clock that will run during each game for one year. Advertising for the company will also be included on a large printed banner that will be hung in the school gym. Social media accounts, school newsletters, and an Ad in the Sylvan Lake News will be used to thank the sponsor. The company will also receive a framed and signed Lakers team photo as well as a thank you card.

Silver - \$5,000 - Limit of 4 businesses - All that the bronze level offers, with an increase to 3 years of advertising as well as a digital commercial that will run on the score clock during the pre-game warmup, timeouts, and post game.

Gold - \$10,000 - Limit of 4 businesses – All that the bronze and silver levels offer, with an increase to 5 years of advertising. Additionally, a weekend tournament held at HJ Cody will be fully sponsored by a Gold Sponsor. Furthermore, the business logo will be placed on the warm up jerseys for each HJ Cody team (6 teams in total for each sport).

The sponsorship is not a charitable receipt generating transaction. However, the sponsorship may be recognized as a tax deductible advertising expense. École H.J. Cody High School would be very grateful for your sponsorship and will represent your company and Central Alberta with enthusiasm and dignity. Please contact me for more details.
