Dear Community Members,

We, at HJ Cody High School, are seeking monetary donations to support our hands-on engaging learning experience of raising rainbow trout in our classroom. This unique opportunity will be promoted throughout our school. We are looking for community donations to cover the cost and to grow the program.

This program, known as Fish in Schools of "FinS" is an Emerald Award-nominated program that has students and teachers work together to maintain and monitor the development of fish in their classroom. Through a five-month period, students learn about healthy aquatic ecosystems, environmental stewardship and fisheries management. Our goal is for our students to foster an appreciation for the natural world and respect wildlife.

While the program provides annual supplies like food and filter material, schools are responsible to source and buy the equipment which includes:

- New 30 Gal Tank (rainbow trout are susceptible to disease)
- Chiller to maintain a temperature between 8 10°C
- Aerator
- Filter
- Under gravel filter
- Gravel
- Siphon

Donations of any amount are greatly appreciated, large donations would certainly help to cover the cost of more expensive equipment like the chiller, filter and tank. Your donation will have a positive impact on our current students as well as future participants in the FinS program at HJ Cody School. As a thank you for your donation, we will proudly display your company's logo on the FinS tank and within the school.
