On April 8, 2024, a partial solar eclipse will be visible, between 11:38 am and 1:45 pm. It is not safe to look at a partial solar eclipse without safety precautions to protect eyesight. Unsafe viewing of the solar eclipse has the potential to result in permanent eye damage including blindness. More safety information can be found on the NASA website. We will be sharing safety information with students, in advance, so they know the risks associated with viewing an eclipse without adequate safety precautions. We would encourage you to also mention this to your children so that they remain safe. To reduce the risk, your child is welcome and encouraged to stay inside the school during the time of the eclipse. Pizza will be available for sale in the Common Area over lunch.
